

EXEMPLARY PROPOSITION

On holding the First Eurasian football tournament among junior football teams (2003 year of birth) of Russia, CIS, EurAsEc and SCO for the “Eurasian Cup” in memoriam of 75-anniversary of Victory of the Soviet people in the Great Patriotic War 1941 – 1945 years.

1. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Popularization and development of youth football for children in Moscow;
- Identification of winners of the Tournament and the best football players of the Tournament;
- Strengthening international sports connections;
- Mass involvement of Moscow residents in systematic physical training and sports;
- The organization of leisure of football fans.

2. DATES AND VENUE

The tournament takes place from October 21 to October 27, 2019 in Moscow.

3. ORGANIZATION AND MANAGEMENT

General management of the preparation and conduct of the tournament is carried out by the Organizing Committee, which approves the main panel of judges (hereinafter referred to as GSK).

4. PARTICIPANTS

The tournament is held in accordance with this approved Rules.

The tournament is attended by 16 teams, which include players no younger and no older than 2003 of birth. The team line-up - 20 people, including 18 players and 2 coaches

5. ADMISSION OF PARTICIPANTS TOURNAMENT

Admission of the Tournament Participants (football players and team officials) is carried out on the basis of the application and decision of the credentials committee. The meeting of the credentials committee is held on the day of arrival of the teams.

Teams form their applications for participation in the tournament. The application must be signed by the head coach and the team doctor.

Tournament participants must submit applications and consent to the processing of personal data to the Organizing Committee of the Tournament by September 1, 2019. Changes to the submitted application are possible until September 1, 2019.

By September 1, 2019, national associations (football federations) must provide the following official team information in electronic format to the following addresses: Nik@eurasiancup.com and info@eurasiancup.com:

- Team photo;
- Information about the club: club history, achievements;

Each team participating in the Tournament must provide the following documents to the mandate committee:

- The team's application list in Russian and English, drawn up in strict accordance with the procedure (the application form must verify the spelling and the names of the players and the names of the players);
- Original citizen passport;
- Samples of team equipment (2 sets of uniforms of field players: leggings, pants, T-shirt, as well as two goalkeeper sets). During the Tournament, each player must be assigned a permanent game number specified in the application. When conducting a mandate commission, the team official must verify the flag, anthem, and team logo with the representative of the mandate commission.

Without the provision of the above documents, the team is not allowed to participate in the Tournament.

6. FORMAT AND CONDITIONS OF THE TOURNAMENT

The matches of the Tournament are held according to the Rules of the game of football, approved by the International Council of Football Associations (IFAB) on March 3, 2017, and also taking into account the requirements of this order of conduct.

The draw for the participating teams of the Tournament is held by the SSC no later than October 1, 2019. The tournament format is 11x11. The tournament is held in two stages: group stage and playoffs.

Preliminary stage: the teams are divided by drawing lots into four groups, five teams, which in the one-round tournament determine the participants of the final stage - 2 best teams from each group.

The winners of the semi-final pairs meet in the finals.

At the preliminary stage of the competition, the duration of the game is two halves for 40 minutes.

At the final stage - two halves of 40 minutes each. Break 10 minutes. During the match 5 substitutions are allowed.

The tournament is held at the stadiums of Moscow: FC FSM, FC Chertanovo, FC Strogino, PFC CSKA, FC Dynamo and FC Spartak Moscow.

Representatives of the teams 40 minutes before the start of the match put the names of the players and their names on the match record. The match protocol includes the names of 18 players. The team - the owner of the field according to the calendar fills in the match report first.

Appointment of judges for the matches held by the Organizing Committee. Before the start of the game, the chief referee of the match is obliged to determine the colors of the uniform (t-shirts, shorts, leggings and goalkeeper uniform) in such a way as to exclude their coincidence. In the case of the combination of colors, the team changes the form, which is named second in the tournament calendar.

After the end of the game, the representatives of the teams and the main referee of the match are obliged to issue the minutes of the game within 10 minutes. If during the game there were warnings, deletions and injuries of football players, as well as violations of the order in the stadium, then the main referee of the match is obliged to make an exhaustive record in the minutes before signing by the representatives of the teams.

Protests on the decision of the referee, taken on the field on the facts that took place in the game, are not accepted. Football players and team leaders participating in the tournament are obliged to observe all the requirements of the Game Rules and this Regulation. The team leaders do not have the right to interfere in the actions of the match judges, they are fully responsible for the behavior of the football players of their team.

If the game was discontinued due to the undisciplined behavior of the players of one of the teams, then this team is credited with a score of 0-3, and the opposing team is awarded a victory with a score of 3-0. In the case of a larger goal difference, the result of the match remains valid.

If the game is not finished due to the fault of both teams, then they are counted defeat with a score of 0-3.

During the tournament, the players are subject to the following disciplinary sanctions:

In case of removal from the field:

- for two warnings in one game - skipping one game
- for the “foul of last hope” - skipping one game;

For other disciplinary sanctions related to the removal of football players, the decision is taken by the Organizing Committee. The judging of the tournament is carried out by the judges recommended and approved by the Organizing Committee of the tournament.

Refereeing is carried out in accordance with the current rules of the game of football (issued March 3, 2017). All players are required to play in the guards, have a neat appearance. The number of a football player on a T-shirt must match the number under which the given football player is recorded in the match report.

The coaches of the teams must, 45 minutes before the start of the match, enter in the minutes the names and the names of the players with their numbers. The names of 18 football players (11 main and 7 substitutes) and 2 official representatives of the teams are entered into the match report. In each match, the replacement of 7 players from among the substitutes entered in the match report is allowed. The team, named after the calendar first - the nominal mistress of the field, fills in the match report first.

Warm-up of spare players is allowed only in the area determined by the match referee.

Team places are determined by the highest amount of points scored in all matches (win - 3 points, draw - 1 point, defeat - 0 points).

In case of equality of points for two or more teams, the teams in the groups are determined by the indicators in the following sequence:

- based on the results of the games between themselves (the number of points, the difference between the goals scored and the goals conceded, the number of goals scored);
- according to the best difference between scored and missed goals in all matches;
- by the highest number of goals scored in all matches;
- in case of equality of all these indicators - by lot.

7. RESPONSIBILITY OF FOOTBALL PLAYERS AND TEAM LEADERS

Footballers and heads of teams participating in the tournament are obliged to comply with all the requirements and norms of this Regulation, while showing high discipline, respect for opponents, referees and spectators. Team leaders do not have the right to interfere in the action of the match judges. In addition, they are responsible to the Organizing Committee for holding the games of their team. If the game was discontinued due to the undisciplined behavior of the football players of one of the teams, then this team is considered a defeat.

8. JUDGING AND INSPECTION OF MATCHES

The judging of tournament matches is carried out in accordance with the Rules of the game. Appointment of judges for the matches is made HSC. The referee of the match, along with the management of the teams, is responsible for observing the rules for admission of football players to the game. Match judge must:

- in advance to inspect the football field, to assess its quality and suitability for the conduct of the match;
- 1 hour before the start of the match, provide the team representative with the match report for entering the names and the names of the players with their numbers, and also compare the colors of the field players and the goalkeepers of the teams in order to prevent their coincidences;
- issue a match report within 15 minutes after its completion. If during the match there were warnings, removals and injuries of football players, as well as violations of the order in the stadium, the match referee is obliged to make an exhaustive record on the score sheet before signing by team representatives.

SSC considers official protests (with the exception of protests on decisions of the referee taken on the field on the facts that took place in the match), filed only 45 minutes after the end of the match.

Protests are considered only if they are submitted in simple written form to the SSC.

The leaders and other officials of the teams do not have the right to interfere in the actions of the judges of the match, they are fully responsible for the behavior of their team players.

Requests of teams to replace referees appointed for the match are not accepted.

The Organizing Committee ensures that the tournament has the equipment necessary for the judge, assistant referees and the reserve judge for the proper performance of their duties.

9. DISCIPLINARY SANCTIONS

For violations committed before, during and after the end of the game, GSK applies the following disciplinary sanctions to national teams, foot-busters and officials:

- warnings;
- disqualification.

In the event of a match termination due to the undisciplined behavior of the football players of one of the teams, this team counts as a technical loss with a score of 0: 3, and a rival team is awarded a victory with a score of 3: 0. In the case of a larger goal difference, the result of the match remains valid.

In the case of participation in a match of an undeclared or unqualified player, the team for which he stands for is a technical loss with a score of 0: 3, and a winning team with a score of 3: 0 is awarded to a rival team. If the match is not finished due to the fault of both teams, technical losses with a score of 0: 3 are counted.

When a team wins a technical victory (3: 0), the balls scored by the players of this team in the match (matches) played, the result (s) of which (s) were then (and) canceled (s), are taken into account in their individual competition .

If a technical defeat is awarded to a team with a score of 0: 3, the balls scored by the football lists of this team in the played match (s), the result of which were then (and) annulled, are not counted in their individual classification.

In respect of football players during the Tournament will be disqualified for offenses committed during the matches:

- for every three yellow cards (warnings) received in different matches of the Tournament - disqualification for one match;
- for two yellow cards received in one game - disqualification for one match (previously received warnings are not canceled);
- for a red card submitted for depriving a player of an opposing team of an obvious opportunity to score a goal - disqualification for one match;

For all disciplinary offenses, including if a player is removed from the field for other reasons, the decision on disciplinary sanctions is made by the SSC.

10. AWARDING OF TOURNAMENT PARTICIPANTS

The winning team of the Tournament shall be awarded with the Cup, and each football player of the team is awarded with a medal. The teams-winners are awarded with memorable prizes, football players - with medals. Prizes will be awarded to the following categories of participants of the Tournament, determined by the Organizing Committee: "best player", "top scorer", "best forward", "best midfielder", "best defender-nickname", "best goalkeeper", "youngest participant", "prize audience sympathy.

The organizing committee has the right to decide on the delivery of other informal team and individuals with prizes.

The teams are awarded by the Organizing Committee.

11. FINANCIAL TERMS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE TOURNAMENT

Participants' secondment (travel to the place of competitions and back, per diem and accommodation) is at the expense of the sending organizations.

All other expenses shall be borne by the host association.

12. SAFETY ENSURE OF THE TOURNAMENT

Competitions are held at sports facilities that meet the requirements of the relevant regulatory legal acts in force in the Russian Federation and aimed at ensuring public order and the safety of participants and spectators, if there are acts of readiness of the sports facility to hold sports events approved in the prescribed manner.

The owners (users) of sports facilities ensure public order and public safety: it is necessary to have a video surveillance system and technical equipment in accordance with the rules for ensuring security during official sports competitions for the organization of access control and inside the object regime.

13. INSURANCE OF PARTICIPANTS

“Challenge Group Insurance Brokers and Consultants” LLC is the only partner in the development of insurance programs aimed at protecting the Tournament as a mass event from various kinds of unrest and confusion, as well as programs aimed at protecting the life and health of athletes, participants, spectators and ordinary citizens of the city of Moscow.

14. CIRCUMSTANCES OF FORCE MAJEURE

On all matters not covered by this Procedure, including force majeure, decisions are taken jointly by the Organizing Committee and the GSC. Such decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
